Christoph C. Paul named Sokrates Award winner

Berlin based lawyer, mediator and EMNI-member Christoph C. Paul, won this year's Sokrates Award for Mediation. The price is bestowed by the Center for Mediation for exceptional achievements in the field of conflict management as a mediator, trainer or scientist.

Working as a mediator since the mid-1990s, Mr. Paul is one of Germany's pioneers in mediation. In 2009 he was honoured with the Federal Cross of Merit on ribbon for his efforts to implement mediation in international parental conflicts.

The price is given to Mr. Paul for being a "mediator of mediation" through his participation in several institutions such as spokesman of BAFM, member of the commission for court-mediation in Berlin and member of the expert body for "Preparation of legislation on mediation" appointed by Germany's Federal Department of Justice.

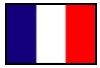
